DUTIES:

- 1. To be responsible to the IT Administrator for:
 - (i) maintaining, repairing and administering the ICT equipment, including all related peripherals;
 - (ii) ensuring the proper maintenance and repairs of ICT equipment;
 - (iii) providing general technical guidance and support to end-users;
 - (iv) devising appropriate systems of security in relation to hardware and software;
 - (v) preparing specifications and advising on the purchase of ICT equipment and spare parts for ICT equipment;
 - (vi) maintaining and repairing all ICT related teaching aids;
 - (vii) to liaise with suppliers for repairs and/or maintenance of ICT equipment; and
 - (viii) troubleshooting network problems.
