Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates who wish to enrol on the following Diploma Programmes of Studies on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute as from the academic year 2025/2026:

- Diploma in Panchakarma (Part Time)
- Diploma in Visual Arts (Full Time)
- Diploma in Performing Arts (Part Time) in the following disciplines:
 - > Bharata Natyam
 - > Kathak
 - > Kuchipudi
 - > Vocal Hindustani Music
 - > Vocal Carnatic Music
 - > Sitar
 - > Violin
 - > Tabla
 - > Mridangam

The General Entry Requirements are as follows:

Either

- (a) Minimum of three (3) credits with at least a "Pass" grade in the English Language at one sitting at the School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level; and
- (b) Passes in at least two (2) subjects at Principal Level at the Higher School Certificate (HSC) or General Certificate of Education Advanced Level.

OR

- (a) Minimum of three (3) credits with at least a "Pass" grade in the English language at one sitting at the School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Ordinary level; **and**
- (b) Possess at least a Diploma (pitched at least level five in the National Qualifications Framework).

OR

- (a) Minimum of three (3) credits with at least a "Pass" grade in the English language at one sitting at the School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Ordinary level;
- (b) Passes in at least one subject at the principal level at the Higher School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Advanced level; and
- (c) passed the Foundation course offered by any one of the public higher education institutions.

OR

Mature students who are at least 25 years must have –

- (a) Minimum of three (3) credits with at least a "Pass" grade in the English language at one sitting at the School Certificate or General Certificate of Education Ordinary level; and
- (b) at least five years of working experience.

<u>OR</u>

Equivalent qualifications acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

Mode of Delivery

All the above Diploma Programmes of Study will be offered on a 3-year part-time basis except for the Diploma in Visual Arts (Full Time) which will be on a 2-year full-time basis.

Fees (for part -time students)

Registration Fee : Rs 300/- (Non-refundable

The Free Tertiary Education Scheme will be applicable to candidates who do not hold any Diploma or Degree qualification. Eligible candidates will pay only Registration and Library fees.

Course Fee : Rs 1000/- per module (Non-refundable)

Mode of Application

• Application forms, duly filled in, must be returned **together with photocopies of birth certificate, marriage certificate (where applicable) and educational certificates** so as to reach the Officer-in-Charge (MGI&RTI) Office, Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka 80808, not later than *Friday 11 July 2025*.

NOTE

- All courses will be held at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka. Courses may be conducted in a blended mode, i.e online and face to face.
- Mature Candidates may also apply for all the above Diploma Programmes of Studies. If they wish to be considered as mature candidate, they have to tick the relevant box in the application form and attach documentary evidence with regard to work experience.
- Applications are also invited from suitably qualified candidates wishing to follow one module or more from the above-mentioned programmes as "Auditeur Libre".
- Applications received after the closing date and/or not supported by the <u>relevant documents</u> will not be considered.
- The programme of study applied for should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.
- Application should be submitted for <u>only one</u> programme of study. Applicants who are already enrolled on a programme of study or course at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute will not be allowed to join another programme concurrently.

- The Mahatma Gandhi Institute reserves *the right not to run any of the programmes* advertised if the number of <u>registered students</u> is not sufficient.
- Applicants are informed that the Mahatma Gandhi Institute is under no obligation to find employment eventually for successful applicants.
- Documents submitted will not be returned to applicants.
