

# An Appreciation of Ghalib's Poetry Part Time

# **INTAKE 2025**

Applications are invited from prospective candidates wishing to enrol on the short course An Appreciation of Ghalib's Poetry (Part Time) on offer at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute, Moka.

This program of study aims at introducing Ghalib's poetry to learners, providing them with elementary knowledge and understanding to appreciate his literary works. This module will make Ghalib's poetry accessible to a wider audience by breaking down complex language and concepts to allow for basic understanding and appreciation of Ghalib's mesmerising verses.

The aim of the course is to:

- Understand the biography of Ghalib and appreciate the different styles of renditions of Ghalib's poetry.
- Demonstrate the basic structural elements of ghazal and read ghazals with correct intonation and pronunciation.
- Discuss Ghalib's influence on literature, popular culture and daily life.

English/Urdu/Hindustani

On a blended mode through Google Meet/ MS Team, Zoom and face to face interaction.

(i) Pass at HSC Level

OR

(ii) A basic understanding of Urdu Language or Hindustani will be beneficial.

OR

(iii) Equivalent qualifications acceptable to the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.
