Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates who wish to be considered for employment on a purely **temporary basis** as **LECTURER (STRINGED INSTRUMENTS)** at the Mahatma Gandhi Institute.

- QUALIFICATION:**
- A.** A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”.
 - B.** A degree in the relevant field from a recognised Institution.
 - C.** A master’s degree in the relevant field from a recognised institution

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A, B and C above acceptable to the MGI & RTI Council

Candidates should be computer literate

Experience in teaching and research is desirable.

Note 1

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above and at Qualification at B above should have been obtained prior to Qualification at C above. However, candidates who as at 30 June 2008, did not possess the qualifications at A above but who possess the qualifications at B and C above will also be considered provided they hold

A Cambridge School Certificate or Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the MGI & RTI Council; and

A PhD or a second Master's Degree or a postgraduate diploma from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the MGI & RTI Council.

Qualification at (a) under "Note 1" should have been obtained prior to Qualifications at B and C above and at (b) under "Note 1".

Note 2

In scarcity areas or where the Mahatma Gandhi Institute faces difficulties to recruit Lecturers, consideration may be given to candidates who possess the qualification at B above.

SALARY: Rs41735/- monthly plus salary compensations at the approved rates.

Bus fares will be refunded at the basis of the number of days of attendance at the approved rates.

DUTIES:

To assist in programme planning and design including the organisation, administration, evaluation and marketing of programmes.

To lecture and conduct tutorials in the relevant subjects and resit subjects.

To prepare teaching and learning materials as well as handouts and learning packs.

To set and mark assignments, examination and resit papers.

To conduct and invigilate examinations.

To assess students and attend committees/panels related examinations.

To supervise and evaluate projects and dissertations.

To enforce student discipline and provide support and guidance to students.

To assist in training needs analysis.

To assist in the organisation and running of workshops, seminars, etc., as and when required.

To promote scholarship and conduct research and consultancy in order to enhance the prestige of the MGI both at national and international level.

To adhere to the Quality Assurance System of the MGI and promote a quality culture within the organisation.

To participate in the editing/production of journals, periodicals, books, etc.

To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Lecturer in the roles ascribed to him.

Applications should be made on the **prescribed form** and returned, duly filled in, along with copies of the Birth, Marriage (where applicable), Academic and Professional Certificates and a valid Certificate of Character so as to reach the Officer-in-Charge, Mahatma Gandhi Institute/Rabindranath Tagore Institute, Moka (80808), ***not later than 3.30 p.m. on Wednesday 03 June 2026.***

Applicants should produce written evidence of equivalence of qualifications, and of knowledge and experience claimed.

The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualifications (if applicable) from the competent authorities rests solely upon the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.

Incomplete and/or inaccurate application forms or application not made on the prescribed forms will not be considered.

The post applied for should be clearly marked on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Please note that applicants who do not possess a Certificate of Character will be required to produce the receipt for their application for same as evidence.
