7. Assessment & Deadlines.

- Each module can be taught in one semester only.
- Each module will be assessed over 100 marks and will be as follows (unless otherwise specified):
 - o Assessment will be based on a written examination of 3-hour duration.
 - The Continuous Assessment will count for 40% 50 % marks of the module and Written Examination will count for 50 60 marks of the module. Continuous Assessment may be based on seminars, practical work and / or assignments and should include at least one class test.
 - Students will be required to write a dissertation between 10, 000 to 14,000 words on a topic which is relevant to the subject and approved by the Departmental Board assisted by a supervisor. Guidance in Research Methodology will be provided in Year I. The dissertation should be original and research based.

For assessment of dissertation, Viva Voce will be mandatory.
